Articles of Association, By-Laws & Regulations

The organisation of the Newark & Nottinghamshire County Show is under the control of a Council.

The Show is held under the Articles of Association, By-Laws and Regulations of the Newark & Nottinghamshire Agricultural Society, which accordingly binds all exhibitors and others attending the Show.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the Show Rules & Regulations (please see copy enclosed) and to the Breed Societies and conditions printed in the Schedule.
Copies of the Articles of Association, By-Laws and Regulations are obtainable on request from the Chief Executive.

The Society reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Show, or any particular section or event, if such cancellation, postponement arises out of strikes, lock-outs, trade disputes or labour problems, or any other cause beyond the control of the Society, including, but without limitation, Act of God, Governmental Act Regulation or request, fire, accident, war, riot or inability to obtain adequate labour, materials or sufficient number of entries.

The Schedule is issued subject to the Orders & Advice of DEFRA – The Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs, and any Local Authorities which may be operative at the time of the Show.

Judging Times Exhibitors entered in all classes must assemble in the Rally Compound by 9.30am; failure to do so may result in exclusion from judging. Class Judging will commence at 10.00am on Saturday 8th May 2010. Championship Judging will commence at 12 noon on Saturday 8th May 2010. For the Championship and Special Awards all exhibitors must remain with their vehicles during judging, otherwise, they will not be judged.

Self-Judge All exhibitors will be given a card on arrival to enable each one to judge every vehicle, excepting their own, entered in their Class. The first two placings to be recorded on the card and signed, after which it should be returned to the Steward. Stewards will finalize the results using a points system.

Awards Presentations will be made at 3.30pm in the following order: s837, s838, s839, s840, s841, s842, s843, s844, s845, s846.

Dress The Committee encourages exhibitors to appear in Period Costume, although no prizes are offered.

Exhibitors entered must assemble in the Rally Compound by 8.30am, as from 10.00am NO vehicles will allowed on to the Showground

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. **Closing Date of Entries**
Entries close Friday 19th March 2010.
It may be necessary to close entries before the advertised date therefore entries should be made as soon as possible.
Entries will not be accepted on the Show day.
2. **Restriction on Vehicles in each Class**
The right is reserved by the Veteran & Vintage Vehicle Rally Committee to restrict the number of entries in each of the classes.
3. **Refusal of Entries**
The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason.
4. **Substitution of Judges**
The right is reserved to substitute judges other than those announced in the Schedule or Catalogue.
5. **Responsibility**
Exhibitors participate in this Rally at their own risk, as the Newark & Nottinghamshire Agricultural Society cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or accident however caused. It is therefore recommended that exhibitors hold an Insurance Policy.
6. **Vehicle Passes**
Each vehicle entered will receive a vehicle pass which will admit the driver of the vehicle plus one passenger onto the showground. Any additional tickets may be purchased at the time of making entries at pre-show prices.
Please note that the admission tickets issued to exhibitors can only be used in the Vehicle Rally Compound entrance (no admittance will be given to pedestrians at the general public entrance gates).
7. **Passes & General Information**
All passes and information will be dispatched 3 weeks prior to the Show.
Information that the exhibitors will receive is:-
Exhibitor Card: this should be filled in neatly and all the Vehicle information should be complete. Entry Pass will admit 2 people.
8. **Tender Vehicles**
No Tender Vehicles will be allowed to park in the Rally Compound due to the lack of space. Parking for Tender Vehicles will be provided and stewards will direct exhibitors to this area.
9. **Insufficient Merit**
Prizes in any class may be withheld if the Judge or Steward is of the opinion that sufficient merit has not been shown.
10. **Judges Decision**
The Judge & Steward's decision is final.

11. **Substitutions of Vehicles**

Substitutions will be allowed at the discretion of the Society subject to the following conditions:

- a. Full details of the new vehicle must be submitted
- b. The new vehicle must be entered in and be eligible for, the same class as the original vehicle.

12. **Cups & Trophies**

Cups & Trophies should be collected from the Rally Commentary Box, which is situated in the Rally Compound.

Cups and Trophies are fully insured by the Newark & Nottinghamshire Agricultural Society. Exhibitors are required to return cups and trophies in good condition, at their own expense when requested to do so by the Society.

It should be noted that exhibitors are forbidden to have any Cup or trophy engraved and it is regretted that anyone who ignores this ruling will be fined a substantial sum to cover the cost of the restitution.

13. **Entry Forms**

Only one entry per Entry form, if you have more than one entry please photocopy the Entry form.
