AT THE VINTAGE TRACTOR & HERITAGE SHOW - 7/8 NOVEMBER 2009**

Last year the Native & Rare Breed Exhibition was introduced to the show with a view to supporting the wonderful animals that have shaped the British Isles over thousands of years. We had a fantastic turnout of Native Breeds, demonstrations and exhibitors who promoted and supported their breed and products that accompany the species. The feedback after the Exhibition was that it was well received by all the visitors to the show. We could not do this without you and your support.

I would like to invite you to bring an exhibit of your breed in order to promote the animals, the products and your business totally free of charge.

This year there will be a timetable of events, which include parades, talks and demonstrations by individual exhibitors. Roving microphones will be made available to those who wish to give the public a talk on their subject.

The Exhibition is also about promoting British Farming and the changes and diversification producers have had to make to keep breeds from going extinct, so we need Traditional and Moderns types for comparisons.

If anyone has access to work-wear from bygone years, or indeed, still being worn today due to the nature of the job, we would be very interested to know about it and hopefully, include it in our displays. Such items might include shepherd huts, smocks, chaps, crooks, or any weird and wonderful quirky piece of memorabilia. Our overall aim is to create a sense of how the animals, their handlers and tools were used, as well as how their role, contributed to shaping the British Isles.
